Below you will find a list of words your student will be reading and writing a lot this month. I strongly encourage you to study these words with your child. I recommend having them practice reading and writing them.

We will be playing an elf hide and seek game with the following sight words:

the, was, as, if, he, she, you, my, was, if, of, like, said,
with see have, look, do, here, are, to, and, little, for, this,
we, see, at, all, went

(Remember we cannot stretch out red words! I will begin sight word spelling tests after the New Year.)

We are also going on word hunts. Students are learning how to trace, read, build, box it, and use the following words:
