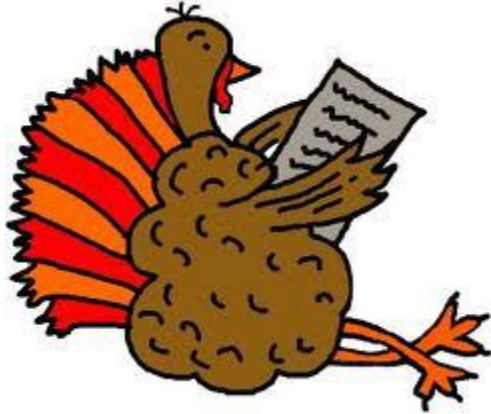


# November Curriculum



This month in communications we will be studying the letters Ll leaf, Gg goat, Tt turkey and letters Zz, Xx, Oo, Yy and li. It family words will also be introduced this month. Sight words you may want to review with your child are; like, little, look, to, the, they, that, there, I, it, is and in. We begin our Fast Start poetry reading program this month as well. The poetry binder will go home Tuesday and should be returned Friday morning.

In Math we will be learning numbers 1-10. Students will be working with terms such as greater than, less than, fewer, more, addition and subtraction. Patterning will continue as well with the use of a 100's grid.
